Bio for Pastor Brian Gearin:

Educationally, I have a B.A. degree from the Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts (formerly North Adams State College) with a Sociology degree and a minor concentration in Urban Affairs graduating in 1981. I have a M.A. from Wheaton College Graduate School in Missions/Intercultural Communications, in Wheaton, Illinois graduating in 1987. I have a Doctor of Ministry DMin Degree from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary in Contextualized Ministry in Urban Settings graduating in 2001.

I have a 38 year history as a foreign and domestic missionary. I served 14 years of that time in Metro-Manila Philippines (1983-1997). During this time, I created (with the LORD's help) a Philippine non-government Christian Community Development organization named DEACON (Developing Empowerment And Concern for Overcoming Need) which helped the urban poor in 24 depressed areas to create livelihood businesses in micro-loan mutual accountability groups. In 1998, I created (with the LORD's help and an indigenous Indian couple Ramesh and Sheba Telore) a revolving micro-loan program in Kohlapur, Maharashtra India named MEDIA (Micro Enterprise Development in India)

At the Emmanuel Gospel Center in Boston, I served from 1997-2008 and created (with the LORD's help) the Network (a ministry that enrolled African-American church congregants in a Individual Development Account Savings and Training program (IDA) to self fund dreams of 1st time home ownership, micro-business development and postsecondary education). From 2008-2017, I served as the Director of Starlight Ministries of the Emmanuel Gospel Center which trained Churches and volunteers to build life-changing relationships with people experiencing homelessness. From 2017- to the present, I created (with the LORD's help) a Christian Consultant ministry named RESTORE (Returning from the Edge: Spiritual Transformational Opportunities for Relational Engagements) assisting ministry leaders with Consultancy services that enhance their effectiveness in training and maintaining ministries with those experiencing homelessness in the Greater Boston area. I serve on the Board of Directors of the Living Waters Ministry of Hope in Lowell.

I served as the Senior Pastor of the 1st Baptist Church of Everett, Massachusetts from 1998-2011. I have 3 children (Ruthi, David and Sarah), 2 step-children (Kaitlin and Becca) and 5 grandchildren (Jaikob, Jayla, Jackson, Gideon and Noah). I have been married for nearly 11 years with my remarkable wife Sandy (a 1st grade teacher at the Park Street Christian school in Boston. We live in West Roxbury, Massachusetts.
