Board games, card games, Hungry Hippos, you name it! Let's hang out in the youth room on April 8th, 7-9 pm.

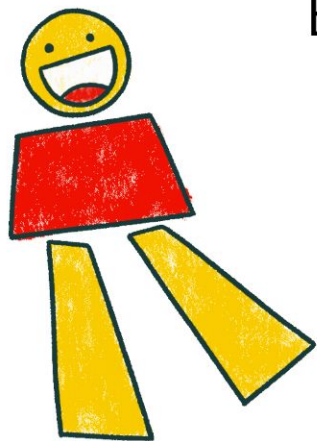

## Covid Update 2/23/2022

- Cornerstone will be following state and town guidelines in regard to COVID-19 mitigation measures.
