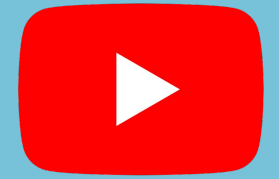

A few days ago Pastor Jonathan shared with us about God's call on the Romig family to move to Colorado this summer. I know I am thankful for the nearly 7 years Jonathan and Monica have been with us and ministering among us in so many ways. I am also very thankful for the more than three months we have as a church to prepare for this huge change. There is both profound sadness in the loss and real excitement for what God has planned for the future. Often, a board of elders would set the vision/direction for a church in transition, but as I noted on Sunday, I am the only elder besides Jonathan currently serving. I believe it is important to form a committee to help guide and direct the church into and through the beginning of this transition.

The committee will be chaired by an elder and include a minimum of one elder and one deacon. I am currently referring to this as the steering committee (but I am open to better names). If you are interested in taking an important and formal role in shaping the future of Cornerstone, I would love to hear from you. The qualifications are a person who: loves God and is committed to seeking His will for Cornerstone through (listening) prayer; loves the church, the bride of Christ; is committed to Cornerstone; and is willing to meet regularly for 3-6 months. My hope is that we are able to form a steering committee of five or more diverse people with a likely maximum of nine members on the team. Participation on this team would not preclude service on a potential future pastoral search committee. The elders will dialogue individually with those interested prior to finalizing the team.

## Covid Update 2/23/2022

- Cornerstone will be following state and town guidelines in regard to COVID-19 mitigation measures.
